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HUSBAND NOTES: John NAY Jr.

LDS Bapt (May 1842): Baptized by Eli P. Magnin (St. George Ward Records), Rebaptized 28 July, 1867, Pine Valley, Utah.

Emigration (12 Oct 1852): John Nay and 8 others arrived in Great Salt Lake on 12 Oct 1852 in Allen Weeks company.

LDS Bapt (28 Jul 1867): Rebaptized 28 July, 1867, Pine Valley, Utah.

Death (1 Oct 1892): Age 88.

Burial (3 Oct 1892): She and John Nay are buried next to each other on the corner of Central and Grand, #128-E, #128-F.

General: Had twelve children. Temple Ref 7311402 05

Angelina Hale, his first wife, left John and their children. Even though no marriage date for the second wife can be located, we assume this happened sometime in Springville, and later John and Thankful Lucy went to St. George and were sealed in the St. George Temple.

Pioneer Indexes, Washington County, Utah, 1852-1870, compiled by Wesley W. Craig and Roberta Blake Barnum, states: Nay, John; wife, Hale, Thirza Angelina; born 23 Feb 1814, Brandon, Rutland, VT, to Dixie in 1862 from Pine Valley, UT next line: Nay, John; Pine, Thankful Lucy, 4 Nov 1830; Stockholm, S.L., NY; to Dixie 1862; from Pine Valley, UT; Marriage date 1859 in Springville, UT. We know that the information about Thirza coming to Dixie is incorrect, and Dr. Craig and Mrs. Barnum cannot find the verification for this record.

On the female Pioneer Index it states that Thankful Lucy came to Dixie in Dec 1861 from St. George, UT.

WIFE NOTES: Thirza Angelina HALE

Living (26 Mar 1887): Thirza apparently gave a Bible to her son, Ormus B. Nay. Inside the cover of this Bible is an inscription from Thirza Angelina Marly to her son Ormus B. Nay.

Death (aft 23 May 1892): Thirza was still alive as late as 23 May 1892 when she wrote a letter pleading for the release of her son Ormus from prison. Family tradition is that Thirza is buried in Monroe, but there is not a legal record of Thirza's burial in Monroe, according to the sexton records there. It is suspected that she could be buried there in one of the graves that are occupied in the "Nay" plot, but not marked. (Out of 8 graves, 5 are marked, 3 unmarked, all occupied.)

Burial: It is uncertain where she is buried. A search has been done by many cousins, and the Monroe City Cemetery says there are plots that appeared to be filled, in the Nay Plot, but no record is on who occupies the plots. They are unmarked graves.

Alt. Name: Thirza apparently gave a Bible to her son, Ormus B. Nay. Inside the cover of this Bible is an inscription from Thirza Angelina Marly to her son Ormus B. Nay.

General: Copied from Family Group Record 15 Jul 1992.

Thirza Angelina Hale, the first wife of John Nay Jr., left John and children, when the latter part of her family was still young. She ran off with a soldier and was not heard from again. Because of Thirza's actions to her family, the Church excommunicated her from the records of the church.

CHILD NOTES: Alonzo Putnam NAY

General: According to the Jackson District Library, Jackson, MI, John and Thirza came to the Territory of Michigan in 1835 from Peterborough, New Hampshire with his two brothers and his first cousin, Pitman Nay, and they all purchased land in Henrietta Township, Jackson County, Michigan. They were living there during the time that Alonzo was born. In the same records there was a reference to John having participated in the first "election" in Henrietta township, placing him there at that time. Alonzo may have been born on the 40 acre farm purchased by his father, which today can be identified by a crossroad intersection.

Ancestral file #1PBP-43 shows Alonzo's birth 22 Nov 1835. Alonzo's headstone shows birth in 1935, though Temple Records Index Bureau. IGI Batch 8517504 Sh 55, Source Call No. 1396037, Film, shows birth of Alonzo Nay to John Nay and Thirza Angelina Hale on 22 Nov 1936 in Jackson, Jackson, MI. IGI Batch 8307401 Sh 82, Source Call No. 0884998, Film, shows Birth of Alonzo Putnum Nay to John Nay and Thirza Angelina Hale on 22 Nov 1835 in Jackson, MI. LDS Ordinan ces: Baptized 18 Sep 1980, SL; Endowed 12 Feb 1858 EH; Sealed to Parents 15 Jun 1983 PV. LDS Vital Records Library in the LDS Family History Suite shows birth as 22 Nov 1836.

Wife's death cert. Utah #CL329748

Family history/Millie Tate; Fountain Green & St. John church records.

Two different documents in an application for Indian War Veteran Medal, signed by Hannah Huggins Nay (his wife) records Alonzo's death as 3 Sep 1910 at the age of 75 years. This date conflicts with the headstone inscription in St. John Cemetery of 4 Sep. 1909, also funeral card printed at the time of his death.

CHILD NOTES: William Edwin NAY

Blessing (2 Nov 1845): Blessing 2 Nov 1845, Nauvoo, Ill. Lineage, Manassah, Patriarch - John Smith

Blessing (12 Aug 1857): Blessing 12 Aug 1857, Cedar Valley, Patriarch - John Young

Military (bet 1865 and 1868): During a skirmish in the Black Hawk War, William shot Ute Chief Noons Antongaur (better known as Black Hawk) who survived his injury. William and the chief later became close friends.

General: Records of members received "William Nay & Wife, Date of Certificate Sept 1889 from Circle Valley Ward, when received: Apr 1889" in Monroe Ward records.

CHILD NOTES: Laura Ann NAY

LDS Bapt (1 Oct 1901): Matilda Nay Dayton served as proxy.

LDS Endow (1 Oct 1901): Matilda Nay Dayton served as proxy.

Burial (1940): The genealogy person at Cypress Lawn Memorial Park in Colma, California wrote the following: Laura A. Capron 44 years and John Saunders Capron 72 years are in our Laurel Hill Mound. Laurel Hill was a cemetery in San Francisco that was moved in 1940. The persons who were moved to Cypress Lawn are buried in underground vaults at Cypress Lawn in an area named "Laurel Hill Mound." There is a plaque there to the memory of all those buried there. Laura died June 16, 1887 in San Francisco.

General: 1880 Utah census has Laura Ann Capron living with oldest daughter and her family.

Marcus Warren said Laura Ann was born 20 Mar. 1843.

Laura's daughter Margaret Ann Warren Vessing and Loretta C. White Cahn, Bert E. White and Louis M. Cahn are buried at Cypress Lawn Memorial Park in Colma, Ca. in Section S Tier 5 Niche 37. Margaret's dates are b. March 18, 1864 d. Jan 20, 1948. Loretta C. White Cahn b. Nov. 16, 1886 d. Sept. 22, 1970. Bert El White b. Nov. 21, 1884 d. Aug. 27, 1942. Louis M. Cahn b. Sept 29, 1882 d. March 2, 1972.

CHILD NOTES: John Hyrum NAY

General: There is a question on the birthplace of John Hyrum. In the 1870 census it is listed as Illinois, which would probably be Nauvoo where the family lived a short time while John was an infant. Other census records list New Hampshire.

Refer to sources for vital statistics and ordinances.

Note: "Endowment reconfirmed and all former sealings ratified for husb on 3 Mar 1969."

Cemetary record stated Good reputation, attending Dr. WO Christensen, white plush casket, brick vault.

Farmer all his life.

CHILD NOTES: Joseph Brigham NAY

General: Joseph Brigham's family group record info from records in family Bible and other records of Joseph Brigham Nay and Amanda Earl Nay. Corres. with Olephia E. Nay King, Fallon, Nev. and Marie Lee, TIB, CFI, CRA, Pine Valley record.

CHILD NOTES: Ormus Bates NAY (twin)

Birth (25 Apr 1850): LDS records show birth as Harris Grove, Iowa.

Misc (bef 30 Apr 1898): Convicted and imprisoned for train robbery.

LDS Bapt (30 Apr 1898): Ormus rebaptized 30 Apr 1898 according to the Circleville Ward records after his prison term.

CHILD NOTES: Angelina Relief NAY

General: There is a conflict on the year of birth for Angeline Relief. Different sources cite 1852, 1853, 1854, 1855.

When she was young (approx 1858), her mother abandoned the family. Angeline then went to live with Mathilda, an older, married sister. While living in St. George, Utah, in the care of her older sister, Angeline died of a fever.
