**Marriage (14 Feb 1891):** George J. Nay and Fannie M. Yount married the 14th of Feb. 1891 in San Bernardino; a M. W. Vale a resident of San Bernardino and O. Whitlock, a residence of San Bernardino and said county were present as witnesses. Signed by George W. White, Pastor First M. E. Church, San Bernardino, Cal.; recorded at the request of Geo. W. White this 14 day of Feb. 1891; County recorder H. S. Davidson by Deputy reorder, Els. Husted

## **HUSBAND NOTES: George John NAY**

**Death (27 Dec 1922):** DEATH RECORD: States that George J. Nay is the son of O.B. Nay. The Informant, James Ruck, Agent of San Bernardino was mistaken as his father was John Nay Jr. of Monroe, Sevier Co., Utah. Reg. No. on bottom left corner of the certificate is 695131, date issued 2 Jul 2001.

**General:** Endowment (living) and bapt. record from Special Collections, Family History Library, SLC UT (end. age 15)

## **WIFE NOTES: Fannie M. YAUNT**

**Death (20 Jun 1960):** She was 90 years old when she died, which leaves one to wonder who took care of her in her aged years, since she had lost all of her immediate family.

**General:** The SSDI was searched for the death of Fannie M. Nay, and it did not show any record for her.

## **CHILD NOTES: Walter James NAY**

**General:** A poem written by Charlotte Jane Doxford Nay to George and Fanny Nay, about the loss of both of their children, mentions Walter as their first child.

---

## **CHILD NOTES: Ethel I. NAY**

**General:** Ethel was still alive on October 1918, according to Needles Eye, however, poem written by Charlotte Jane Nay Doxford in November 1918 expressed sympathy and comfort for George and Fanny Nay, mentioning both children by name who had died.

**DEATH SOURCE:** Family story was that Ethel was 21 and unmarried when she died. Death certificate was not on California Index as birth was prior to 1940.

"THE NEEDLES EYE" 4 October 1918: Mr. and Mrs. George Nay drove overland from the San Bernardino mountains where they have been for the last two months camped at Big Bear Lake, arriving here Wednesday. Miss Ethel Nay came home by train.

It is possible that Ethel came home too ill to travel by car and died soon after. It is also possible that she might have died on that vacation and came home by train in her casket. A birth and death certificate has been sent for on 1/19/02 from San Bernardino Co., CA. but has not been received as of April 2002.
