Death (11 Jan 1937): Obituary: Ormus Morley Nay, Spanish American War veteran, passed away at his home in Sweetwater Nevada, January 11, 1937 and was buried in Alturas, Jan 16 from the Kerr Mortuary. He was aged 64 yrs. Mr. Nay was stricken shortly before breakfast on the morning of Jan 11 and lived about five hrs. His wife and son William were with him at the time of his passing. Mr. Nay together with his family lived in Modoc county for a number of years, part of which time was spent in Alturas where he was associated in the feed business with Mr. Laver. Besides his wife Clara, he leaves to mourn his passing, a daughter Mrs. Marcia Mulkey of Davis Creek, three sons, William Nay, of Sweetwater, Nv. Lawrence Nay of Gerlach, Nv. and Wilbur Nay of Likely, Ca. and three grandchildren. Mrs. Nettie Laver, a granddaughter, passed away about a month ago.
